#### **HOW TO REGISTER:**

CLASS SIZES ARE LIMITED. Registrations will be taken on a first-come, first served basis.

You may register at the Open House or by mail.

#### New Students

- 1. Select your classes. Please ask if you have questions about placement!
- 2. Download and print the registration form and liability waiver. from our website
- 3. Fill out both forms, and mail them with your check to the studio, OR bring them to Open House.
  - 4. Make sure to read our studio policies and COVID-19 guidelines.
- 5. Students who started dance this summer: your instructor will email you with your class placement.

### Returning Students:

- 1. Select your classes. Combination ballet and tap students will move up one level (for example, if you were in Level 2 last year, you will be in Level 3 this year). Speak to your instructor if you wish to take a class that requires teacher approval.
- 2. Email your class choices and mail your check to the studio, or jot them down and mail them with your check. It is not necessary to fill out another registration form.
  - 3. You may also register at Open House.
- 4. You MUST update your registration and liability waivers. You will need to initial and date your liability waiver by the end of first week of class. Also please check your registration form for any changes the first week of class.

All students: your registration is not complete until I receive your payment.

Registration deadline: Wed. August 31.

Classes without 5 prepaid registrations by August 31 may be canceled.

#### **DRESS CODE:**

- 1. Students MUST have hair secured off the face and neck for dance classes. Please leave jewelry at home.
- 2. For girls: Pink tights are preferred unless otherwise specified. The "ballet pink" color shows the lines and definitions of the muscles, and helps the instructor see what's really going on. Black or pink leotards are preferred.
- 3. For boys: Plain white t-shirt (no logos) that fits snugly, and either plain black spandex bike shorts or jazz pants. Pants must fit snugly. NO POCKETS, PLEASE! As your male student matures, speak to your instructor about a dance belt.
- 4. Ballet skirts: Ballet skirts are NOT recommended for students under the age of seven they play with them too much! Students ages 7-9 should wear a skirt with an elastic waist. Older students should wear a wrap skirt that ties.

#### **ABOUT SHOES:**

- 1. Please do not buy dance shoes "to grow into." Shoes should fit "like a glove." First time students will benefit from visiting a dancewear store and having their feet professionally measured, or I can measure your child's feet. For insurance and liability reasons, students without properly fitting shoes will not be permitted to take class. Improperly fitted shoes can damage your child's feet. Speak to your instructor if you have questions about sizing.
- 2. Girls need pink ballet slippers and black tap shoes. Boys need black ballet slippers and black tap shoes.
- 3. **PLEASE trim the elastic drawstring in ballet shoes before the first class!** Tighten the drawstring, tie it in a knot, and snip off all but about an inch. If you need me to do this for you, PLEASE DON'T WAIT until the first day of class!
- 4. If you buy tap shoes with pre-sewn elastic, please make sure the student can slip the shoe on and off easily. Also make sure that the shoe will not fly off the child's foot. It may be necessary to replace or adjust the elastic. If there is a ribbon, please remove it.

#### WHERE TO BUY:

- 1. Shoe Exchange: We have a box at the studio where parents can buy and sell gently-used shoes and dancewear. We also have a small selection of tights, leotards, and ballet skirts.
- 2. Visit www.discountdance.com and click on the Dance Teacher Program link along the left-hand side. Enter **Teacher Code TP63066** to see recommended items for our studio. You can also receive special discounts. Be sure to read the sizing information!
- 3. Visit a dancewear store. I recommend Dancewares, 2120 Winthrop Road, or Bobby's Dancewear, 5400 South 56th St,, both in Lincoln. I can measure your child's feet, or call one of the stores to make an appointment for a fitting.
